Fund Investment

The money is invested with and professionally managed by one of the following, as selected by the LWML IED Board of Directors:

Disbursement

The annual 5% distribution from the Fund shall be used for Student Aid for LCMS Iowa District East students who will be or are attending LCMS colleges or universities and who intend to go into full-time church work.
