MINUTES OF THE IOWA EAST DISTRICT LUTHERAN WOMEN'S MISSIONARY LEAGUE 39TH BIENNIAL CONVENTION June 15-16, 2018

The 39th Biennial Convention of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Iowa East District was held at the Marriott Hotel, Cedar Rapids June 15-16, 2018. The LWML members of the Mt. Pleasant Zone hosted the convention. Judy Westergren served as the convention parliamentarian.

PROCESSIONAL - OPENING WORSHIP SERVICE - OFFERING

The processional hymn, "Lift High the Cross", opened the first session at 1:00 pm. The procession was led by DeEtta Rasmussen, Mt. The worship service was led by Mt. Pleasant Zone Pastoral Counselor, Rev. Christopher Roepke. officiant and lector and the clergy of the Mt. Pleasant Zone. The message was delivered by Rev. Dr. Brian Saunders, proclaimer. The Convention Offering #1 was designated for the Iowa East District 2018-2020 Mite Goal.

SESSION I – FRIDAY AFTERNOON

CALL TO ORDER...PLEDGE TO THE FLAGS...WELCOME...LCMS IDE PRESIDENT...LCEF

President Joan Berquist called the 39th Biennial Convention of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League Iowa East District to order in the name of the Triune God, the Father, our Creator; the Son, our Redeemer and the Holy Spirit, our Sanctifier at 2:00 p.m. DeEtta Rasmussen, President of the Mt. Pleasant Zone led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag and the Christian flag. Angie Banko and Karen Lyons Convention Co-Chairmen welcomed all attendees to the 2018 Iowa East District Convention. Betty Borchardt, President of St. Ansgar Zone, responded and thanked the host committee and zone for organizing the convention. LCMS Iowa District East President, Rev. Dr. Brian Saunders, informed us of the work our District is doing through Missions. He thanked the LWML for the support they continue to give. The power of your Mites help make the mission projects we are working on happen. Carole White, LCEF District Vice President, brought greetings from the Lutheran Church Extension Fund and informed us of some of the services they offer to our District. A new service they are offering is electronic giving for mites called "Joyful Response". President Berquist thanked LCEF for their matching fund gift of \$500.00 that was presented for mission grants through the "Rock-a-Thon for Mites" project.

The District Banner was designed and made by Shirley Schweer and features the newest logo of LWML Iowa East District. The District Board of directors approved this banner to be used at all LWML IED Conventions. Sara Scudder, a member of Faith Lutheran Church, Mt Pleasant, designed the 2018 convention logo. The convention banner was designed and made by Mary Fitzpatrick and Marcie Johnson, members of Zion Lutheran Church, Wilton. Amanda Hahn and Rachel Wegener, who represented Iowa East as Young Woman Representatives at the 2017 LWML Convention in Albuquerque, carried the Iowa East District banner and the 2017 Albuquerque convention banner in our processional today. The Albuquerque convention banner was designed by Naomi Pfeil and made by Naomi and her mother, Angie Pfeil, from the Cedar Rapids Zone. Zone Presidents carried banners made by their zone showing their interpretation of our convention theme, "Grafted to the Vine". President Berquist introduced the Crisis Management Team and asked them to stand and be recognized. Seated at the head table were – Judy Westergren, Parliamentarian; Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary, Cynthia Kofoot, VP of Gospel Outreach and Pastor David Lingard, Senior Pastoral Counselor. Serving as the president's page was Becky Wehrspann, District Meeting Manager. Jeanette Kreutner, President of the Dubuque Zone, recognized special guests: Katie Schuermann, banquet keynote speaker; President Patti Ross, LWML Representative; Shari Moeller and Sandy Speidel, song leaders and accompanist; mission speakers Rev. Ryan McDermott and family; Deaconess Grace Rao; Gracie, the comfort dog with handler Jane Marsh-Johnson and Rev. Dr. Brent Smith, Mission Central. President Berquist recognized Zone and District Pastoral Counselors, pastors, retired clergy and all current and retired pastor's wives and widows; the nine (9) YWRs attending; the first timers to convention and the three IED LWML'ers serving appointed positions with LWML, Becky Wehrspann, Features Editor for the Lutheran Woman's Quarterly; Cheryl Killham, Leadership Development Committee and Vickie Ozburn, LWML Convention Food Services. Past IED Presidents, Lynn Evans (1990-1994), Judy Westergren (1998-2002), Kathryn Schweer (2002-2006) and Janice Johnston (2010-2014) led the LWML Pledge. Marlene Bartlett (1986-1990) and Gail Maurer (1994-1998) were unable to attend. Convention interrupter, Martha Hartwig made an appearance, encouraging us to do a "happy dance".

CREDENTIALS.....ADOPTION OF AGENDA/ RULES....2016 MINUTES

Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary, presented the credentials report: as of June 15, 2018 at 1:00 pm a quorum is present with all 12 zones represented. Out of a possible 200 eligible delegates from 12 zones there are a total of 80 eligible delegates, nine (9) District Officers and 12 Zone Presidents for a total of 101 eligible to vote. Also attending are 17 non-voting Board of Directors and 94 other registrants for a total in attendance of 212. Paulson moved that the roll of voting Board of Directors and delegates registered as of 1:00 pm on June 15, 2018 be the official roll of the voting assembly of the convention. Motion was seconded and carried. Janell Wollschlager, Vice President of Organizational Resources, by direction of the Board of Directors moved to adopt the convention agenda as printed on pages 23-26 of the convention manual with necessary changes at the discretion of the Chair. Motion carried. Cheryl Killham, Vice President of Communication read the convention rules printed on page 22 of the convention manual. By direction of the Board of Directors, Cheryl moved to adopt the convention rules as printed. Motion carried. President Berquist announced that to comply with the convention rules just adopted, all delegates must be registered, seated at the reserved delegate tables and be wearing the delegate name badge. Since the 2016 convention minutes located on pages 31-38 in the convention manual have been reviewed, corrected and approved by the LWML IED Board of Directors and sent to all delegates and societies that did not have a delegate at the convention, Diane Paulson, Recording

Secretary, moved to suspend the reading of the 2016 convention minutes. Motion seconded and carried. A singing break took place.

Randolph McHone. Elizabeth Gehle, Financial Secretary, stated the Financial Secretary's report is located on pages 39-41 of the convention manual. The report contains a listing of the contributions from societies, zones, and other sources of income. This report has been reviewed by LWML member Tamara McKay of the Davenport Zone and found to be in good order. Her statement can be found on page 41 of the convention manual. Gehle moved acceptance of the Review of the Financial Secretary's report. Motion seconded and carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT.....MISSION GOAL.....MITES IN ACTION,,,,,,MISSION GRANTS

Gretchen Rasmussen, Treasurer, stated that the Treasurer's Report is located on pages 42-43 of the convention manual. This report has been reviewed by LWML member Tamara McKay of the Davenport Zone and found to be in good order. Her statement can be found on page 41 of the convention manual. Rasmussen moved acceptance of the Review of the Treasurer's report. Motion was seconded and carried. By direction of the Iowa East Board of Directors, Rasmussen moved to adopt a Mission Goal for the 2018-2020 biennium of \$208,795.00 which includes \$97,000.00 for Mission Grants, \$100,495.00 for Outreach and \$11,300.00 for In-reach. Motion seconded and carried. The assembly stood and sang the Doxology. President Berquist introduced, "Mites in Action" Mission Speaker, Pastor Ryan McDermott and his family who shared with us how our mites have been used in his ministry in West and Central Africa, based in Togo, working in the deaf ministry. Cynthia Kofoot, Vice President of Gospel Outreach, presented the proposed Mission Grants printed on pages 45-54 of the convention manual to be considered for the 2018-2020 Biennium. Jill Fraser, VP of Human Care, offered a prayer before balloting. President Berquist gave the voting instruction. Delegates were instructed to vote for eight (8) mission grants. Nondelegate tellers distributed and collected the ballots. The Christian Life Committee presented a skit, featuring "Stars: Shiners, Sparklers and Fire Balls". Let your faith shine like stars.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT...BALLOTING

Nominating Committee chairman, Lilah Hurley, Davenport Zone, was unable to be present — Marie McNary, Cedar Rapids Zone, substituted for her and presented the slate of candidates — President: Margaret Kistler, Cedar Rapids Zone; Vice President of Christian Life: Elizabeth Roberts, Williamsburg Zone and Becky Wehrspann, Westgate Zone; Vice President of Gospel Outreach: Judith Fink, Waterloo Zone and Elizabeth Gehle, Davenport Zone; Financial Secretary: Tamera McKay, Davenport Zone and

Marna Mohr, Williamsburg Zone; Recording Secretary: Virginia Boyer, Cedar Rapids Zone, and Lora Duncan, Eldora Zone; Junior Pastoral Counselor: Rev. Tom Ogilvie, Williamsburg Zone and Rev. Christopher Roepke, Mt. Pleasant Zone. President Berquist after asking for nominations from the floor, of which there were none, declared the nominations closed. Nancy Maurer, President of Westgate Zone led the prayer before balloting for the Election of Officers. Delegates were instructed to vote for one (1) for each office. The non-delegate tellers distributed and collected ballots.

LWML REPORT....ANNOUNCEMENTS

Margaret Kistler, President of the Cedar Rapids Zone, introduced the LWML Representative, President Patti Ross. President Ross presented the LWML report, updated us on the LWML Mission Grants and encouraged us to continue to support them with prayer and monetary gifts. She shared that the LWML is a place where each woman is valued for her uniqueness in God's plan for His church and is engaged in using her special God given gifts, as she is equipped through the word. LWML is so special because its focus is on Jesus and what He has done for us; bringing the saving gospel to the world. Angie Banko and Karen Lyons offered announcements. President Berquist shared additional announcements; President Berquist declared Session I of the LWML IED 39th Biennial Convention be closed. The Exhibit Hall was open from 4:30 pm - 6:15 pm.

FRIDAY EVENING

The Banquet began at 6:30 pm with a welcome and prayer from Pastor Randolph McHone, Junior Pastoral Counselor. Following dinner, President Joan Berquist introduced the keynote speaker, author, Katie Schuermann. Her most recent non-fiction books include, "*He Remembers the Barren*" and "*Pew Sisters*". She is also the author of a the "*Anthems of Zion*" trilogy fiction books. Christian Life Committee Chair, DeEtta Rasmussen presented a video of District activities in celebration of the "75th Anniversary" of LWML. The closing prayer was offered by Pastor David Lingard, Senior Pastoral Counselor. Exhibits were open from 9:00 pm – 10:00 pm.

SESSION II - SATURDAY MORNING

OPENING DEVOTION....CREDENTIALS REPORT...SECOND OFFERING

The morning session began at 7:45 am with group singing led by Shari Moeller and Sandi Speidel. President Joan Berquist welcomed the assembly to Session II of the 39th Biennial Convention of the LWML Iowa East District at 8:00 am. President Berquist recognized the Past District Presidents and LWML President Patti Ross. Opening devotion were led by the Young Women Representatives introduced by Lavonne Hoversten, Chairman of the Member Development Committee and assisted by committee member, Tamara McKay. The devotion was entitled, "Love for the Vineyard". Seated on stage was Judy Westergren, Parliamentarian; Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary; Vickie Ozburn, Vice President of Christian Life and Rev. Randolph McHone, Junior Pastoral Counselor. Crisis Management Team members were recognized. Offering #2, designated for the LCMS Disaster Relief Fund, was gathered with the singing of "Lutheran Women, One and All". Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary reported as of 8:00 am this morning there is no change in the number of the voting body, which remains at 101. Alberta Martens, President of the Clinton Zone, led the assembly in reading the LWML Mission Statement.

BYLAWS..... LHM.....BIBLE STUDY

Janell Wollschlager, Vice President of Organizational Resources, presented the Proposed Bylaw Amendments. The proposed bylaw amendments were reviewed at the November 11, 2017 BOD meeting and approved by the LWML IED Board of Directors. The changes were sent to the LWML Structure Committee and approved in December 2017. This past spring, each society was provided a copy of the

proposed amendments along with the rationale for the changes. By direction of the LWML IED Board of Directors, Wollschlager moved that the proposed bylaw amendments be approved as presented from pages 61-62 of the convention manual. Each article and section of the proposed bylaw amendments was read. Sharon Mulford-Henson, President of the Eldora Zone, led us in prayer before voting on the proposed bylaw amendments. President Berquist called for the vote from the Official Roll of the Voting Assembly. By your vote, you have adopted the bylaw amendments as presented. Janell Wollschlager informed the voting body that the bylaws will be published and distributed to the Zone Presidents at the August 18, 2018 LWML IED Board of Directors meeting, who will distribute them to the society presidents at their Zone Fall Board meeting. They will be published on the IED website. President Joan Berquist welcomed Mr. Rad Finch, Ministry Advancement Officer with the Lutheran Hour Ministries, who brought greetings from LHM. He announced that an anonymous donor, whom he has been working with and has a great love for LWML, has gifted the LWML IED Endowment Fund with a \$15,000 thank offering and also has willed from her estate an irrevocable gift of \$291,000. To God be the Glory!! The assembly stood and sang the Doxology. Rev. David Lingard, Senior Pastoral Counselor, led Bible study #1 found on page 27 of the convention manual, based on John 15:16-17, "Grafted to the Vine". We have been grafted into Jesus; our strength is in Him. "There is peace and joy in Jesus choosing you because it is certain and sure, your strength is not in yourself but in the one true vine, Jesus Christ, the vine you have been grafted into, now go and bear fruit!"

MISSON GRANTS REPORT....MISSION SPEAKERS....LWML PRESIDENT.

Linda Jeske, Mission Grants Teller Committee Chair, reported the number of votes each grant received. The mission grant total for the 2018-2020 biennium is \$104,500 (\$97,000 plus a carryover of \$7,500 from 2016-2018 biennium).

She also helps to lead the development of deaconess ministry curriculum and education overseas and supports national LCMS deaconess training programs. The work of the deaconess program focuses on the word and sacraments, serving the Lord through His love and sharing His compassion and mercy through those who He brings to us.

Shari Moeller and Sandi Speidel led the pre-session group singing. President Joan Berquist thanked these song leaders for sharing their talents with us during this convention.

OPENING PRAYER.....MITES IN ACTION,,,,ROCK-A-THON REPORT

President Berquist opened Session III of the 39th Biennial Convention of LWML Iowa East District by introducing individuals seated at the head table – Judy Westergren, Parliamentarian; Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary; Elizabeth Gehle, Financial Secretary and Rev. David Lingard, Senior Pastoral Counselor. Sandi Duncan, President of Marshalltown Zone, offered the opening prayer for Session III. President Berquist introduced our next "Mites in Action" speaker, Rev. Dr. Brent Smith from Mission Central, who works alongside Gary Thies. Their mission is to inform congregations and their members the work of LCMS National and International Missions; while also connecting people with opportunities to support missionaries and projects with prayer, encouragement and voluntary giving. Janell Wollschlager, "Rock-a-Thon" coordinator gave us an update. We have collected \$3,201.80, from the "Rock-a-Thon for Mites", with more funds coming.
