BOD MINUTES FROM MAY 5, 2018: Minutes were accepted as printed.

MINUTES REVIEW FOR 39TH BIENNIAL CONVENTION: Janell Wollschlager and

APPOINTMENTS: Janell Wollschlager was appointed as meeting parliamentarian.

REPORTS:

TREASURER: Gretchen Rasmussen reported. Submitted report attached.

The beginning balance as of April 30, 2018 was \$28,029.53; income received was \$6,943.37; expenses were \$4,829.71; leaving a balance of \$30,143.19 as of June 2, 2018.

Gretchen made a motion to recommend to the convention body to set the Mission Grant Goal at \$97.000.00 for the 2018-2020 Biennium (at the recommendation of the Ex. Committee). Motion was carried.

FINANCIAL SECRTARY: Elizabeth Gehle reported. Full report submitted.

Society contributions for the 2018-2020 biennium as of June 2018, totaled \$15,450.95. We received \$5.00 from Thrivent Choice in June and have received no donations from Ready Set Recycle. **VP OF ORGANIZATIONAL RESOURCES:** Janell Wollschlager reported. Full report submitted. **Rock-A-Thon:** \$924 in pledges have been received as of June 4, 2018. \$500.00 will be matched by LCEF.

NEW BUSINESS:

Accept Convention Agenda: Gretchen Rasmussen made a motion to accept the convention agenda as printed in the convention manual on pages 23-26. Motion was seconded and carried.

Adopt Convention Rules: Helen Huedepohl made a motion to adopt the convention rules as printed on page 22 of the convention manual. Motion was seconded and carried.

Set Number of Mission Grant Votes: The Executive Committee made a recommendation to set the number of mission grants at eight (8) votes per voter. Recommendation carried.

Banquet Seating/Convention Seating: The table arrangement and table numbers were reviewed. Tables will be clearly marked Delegates, BOD, General Seating. Guests will be seated with the BOD. Banquet seating is open. If you are hosting a guest, please sit with your guest at the banquet and throughout the convention.

Designate Voting Member to make motion to Destroy Ballots: Sandi Duncan volunteered to make the motion on Saturday to destroy the ballots.

YWR/ Pins: We have nine (9) YWRs representing seven (7) zones. They will be meeting in the Iowa City room and be sitting with their zone president during the convention. The Zone Presidents elected to present the YWRs with their YWR pins. We will also present to the YWRs one of the new IED Convention Badges with the new LWML Logo.

Processional Order: Was reviewed. Becky Wehrspann and Marie McNary will help with the processional order.

Convention Script will be on the podium for each speaker to read. President Joan instructed us how to use the script. The Pastoral Counselor on stage will watch to make sure the correct page is in place at all times.

Tellers: Delegates should not be appointed tellers, as they can't handle the ballots before voting. Dori Stanek will act as ballot chair for both the Mission Grants and Election of Officers with the help of ten (10) tellers, who are not delegates, to distribute and collect ballots. The delegate/tellers are able to help count the votes, so they will remain in place for that.

Mission Grant/Resolution Presentation: Cindy Kofoot will abbreviate the presentation to the name of the mission grant with the resolution in order to shorten the presentation time.

Banner Placement for Stands: the floor will be marked with the name of your zone where the banners are to be placed. Delegates were asked to find the place their banner is marked before the processional, so you will know where to put it.
