ALIVE: Reviewed the Fall Alive article submissions. A few helpful suggestions when someone submits an article for the Alive: (1) only use one period in between sentences, (2) refer to the LWML Style Guide on lwml.org for proper capitalization and abbreviation.

Zone Officer and Society Officer Forms: Each zone president has a packet with the new zone officer and society officer's forms. Instructions for completing the forms are in the envelope. The forms and instruction letters are also available on the LWML IED website at: http://lwml-ied.org/society-resources/. Once I receive the forms back, I will make the needed copies and hand out at the following BOD meeting. These forms are very important because they have the names of officers in case someone needs to be contacted, the number of members, and the number of *Quarterly and ALIVE in Iowa East District* subscriptions being distributed to each society each year. *Please stress to your societies that it is important that I receive decreases in subscription numbers by January 31st, 2020. Even if there is no change in officers, a new form needs to be submitted if the society wishes to change their subscription numbers. The request to change subscription numbers must be given to the Vice President of Communication and not the Financial Secretary.*

As of July 31st, I have received 87% of Society Record forms for calendar year 2019. Society Record Forms that have not been received for 2019: Benton Zone (3), Cedar Rapids Zone (3), Clinton Zone (3), Davenport Zone (2), Dubuque Zone (1), Mt. Pleasant (1), Waterloo Zone (2). Please remind each Society that those are still needed to keep our records up to date, even if there are no changes. *All subscription decreases were due by January 31, 2019 for the 2019 Alive and Quarterly subscriptions.*

Society Subscription Statements: "Bills" for the Quarterly and ALIVE subscriptions are prepared in early February, and mailed (or emailed if provided on Society Record form and copying the society president) to each Society Treasurer based on their society record form. Their payment should be sent to the District Financial Secretary, Marna Mohr. Please remind the societies that they should NOT send their payment to St. Louis or to me. While we ask that the local society pay for their subscriptions, we do know that there are societies that do not have the funds to pay this expense. If they cannot pay, they are asked to let the District Financial Secretary know of their situation. Perhaps they can pay a portion of it. We do not want anyone to be without a quarterly or alive because of a shortage of funds in their local treasury.

There are 10 societies who have not paid or have partially paid their Alive and Quarterly subscription bill for a total of \$459 remaining to be collected. Please contact those societies who have not paid to get their payment in as soon as possible. Payment needs to be sent to Marna Mohr. If a subscription does not get paid by the society, the district mites must cover that expense.
