LUTHERAN WOMEN'S MISSIONARY LEAGUE
38TH BIENNIAL CONVENTION
June 17-18, 2016**

“The Ultimate GPS, God’s Plan of Salvation” based on Jeremiah 29:11

The 38th biennial convention of Lutheran Women's Missionary League (LWML) Iowa East District was held at the William Penn University, Oskaloosa, Iowa on June 17-18, 2016. The LWML members of the Marshalltown Zone hosted the convention. Marilyn Eglund served as the convention parliamentarian.

PROCESSIONAL - OPENING WORSHIP SERVICE - OFFERING

The processional hymn, “Lift High The Cross”, opened the first session at 1:00 pm. The procession was led by Sandi Duncan, carrying the processional cross, accompanied by Evie McKain Marshalltown Zone YWR followed by co-chairs Julia Dlouhy & Melanie Maddick carrying the 2016 Convention Banner. Zone Presidents followed accompanied with their Zone YWR carrying their Zone Banners; Appointed District Officers and Committee Members followed. Gretchen Licht (2015 YWR) carried the District Banner and Alice Hoffmeier (Unsung Hero at 2015 Convention) carried the 2015 IED Convention Banner followed by the elected officers and Past District Presidents Lynn Evans, Judy Westergren, Kathy Schweer and Janice Johnston. Keynote Speaker Janice Wendorf, LWML Representative Debbie Larson, all Clergy participating in the worship Service and District President Joan Berquist followed. Clergy of the Marshalltown Zone served in the opening worship service, with the message delivered by Rev. Alex Post, Marshalltown Zone Counselor, Proclaimer. The Convention Offering #1 was designated for the Iowa East District 2016-2018 Mite Goal.

SESSION I – FRIDAY AFTERNOON

CALL TO ORDER.....SALUTE OF FLAGS.....WELCOME

President Joan Berquist called the convention to order in the name of the Triune God, the Father our Creator; the Son our Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit our Sanctifier at 2:00 pm. Seated at the head table were – Marilyn Eglund, Parliamentarian; Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary and Pastor David Rempfer, Senior Pastoral Counselor. Serving as the president’s page was Becky Wehrspann, District Meeting Manager. Sandi Duncan, Marshalltown Zone President, led the Pledge of Allegiance to the United States flag and the Christian flag. Julia Dlouhy and Melanie Maddick, Convention Co-Chairmen, welcomed all attendees to the 2016 Iowa East District Convention. Angie Banko, Mt. Pleasant Zone President responded and thanked the host committee and zone for organizing the convention. The Rev. Dr. Matthew Rueger, Second Vice President of the LCMS Iowa District East brought greetings from President Rev. Dr. Brian Saunders, informing us of the work our District is doing through Missions. Ruth Gerken, LCEF Promotion Director, on behalf of Carol White, LCEF District Vice President, brought greetings from the Lutheran Church Extension Fund. President Berquist thanked LCEF for matching funds up to \$500.00 to support Mites for Missions through the “Repurpose Your Purses for Mites”. Richard Hoelz, President, brought greetings from the Lutheran Layman's League Iowa District East.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS.....LWML PLEDGE

President Joan Berquist thanked all who participated in the opening ceremony: Barbara Fremder for leading us in song before worship and serving as our worship accompanist, the Clergy of Marshalltown Zone: Zone Counselor, Rev. Alex Post, Proclaimer; Rev. David Klinge and Rev. Samuel Beltz, Liturgists and Rev. Dean Christ, Lector. The District Banner was designed by Dennis Rury prior to the 2010

Convention and made by Jean Baker of the Davenport Zone. The LWML Iowa East District Board of directors approved this banner to be used at all LWML IED Conventions. The 2016 convention logo was designed by Jon Dlouhy, son of Julia Dlouhy, Convention Co-chair. The banner was designed and made by Beth Tepe from the Marshalltown Zone. Alice Hoffmeier, who represented Iowa East as our unsung hero at the 2015 LWML Convention in Des Moines, carried the IED banner from that convention in the procession. The banner was designed by Kathy Krueger of Mesa, Arizona and made by Lynda Krueger of the Williamsburg Zone. Zone presidents carried banners interpreting the convention theme. President Berquist introduced the Crisis Management Team and asked them to stand and be recognized. Denita Krause, Dubuque Zone President introduced special guests: Janice Wendorf, keynote speaker; Debbie Larson, LWML Representative; Barbara Fremder, song leader and accompanist; Mission Speakers, Rev. Bart Day and Rev. Robert and Sue Pfeil. President Berquist recognized Zone and District Pastoral Counselors, pastors, retired clergy and retired pastor's wives and widows, the seven YWR's attending and the first timers to convention. Past Presidents, Lynn Evans (1990-1994), Judy Westergren (1998-2002), Kathy Schweer (2002-2006) and Janice Johnston (2010-2014), led the LWML Pledge. Convention interrupter, "Maddie" (Marcia Reints) made an appearance.

CREDENTIALS....ADOPTION OF AGENDA & RULES...2014 MINUTES

Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary, presented the credentials report: as of 1:00 pm, June 17, 2016 a quorum is present with all 12 zones represented. Out of a possible 200 eligible delegates from 12 zones there are a total of 88 eligible delegates, nine District Officers and 12 Zone Presidents for a total of 109 eligible to vote. Also attending are 13 non-voting Board of Directors and 97 other registrants for a total in attendance of 219. Paulson moved that the roll of voting Board of Directors and delegates registered as of 1:00 pm on June 17, 2016 be the official roll of the voting assembly of the convention. Motion was seconded and carried. Judy Westergren, Vice President of Organizational Resources, by direction of the Board of Directors moved to adopt the agenda as printed on pages 18-21 of the Convention Manual with necessary changes at the discretion of the Chair. Motion carried. Vickie Ozburn, Vice President of Communication, by direction of the Board of Directors moved to adopt the convention rules as printed on page 17 of the Convention Manual. Motion carried. President Berquist announced that to comply with the Convention Rules just adopted, all delegates must be registered, seated at the reserved delegate tables and be wearing the delegate name badge. Since the 2014 Convention minutes located on pages 24-29 in the Convention Manual have been reviewed, corrected and approved by the LWML IED Board of Directors and sent to all delegates and societies that did not have a delegate at the convention, Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary, moved to suspend the reading of the 2014 Convention minutes. Motion seconded and carried.

Her statement can be found on page 32 of the Convention Manual. Gehle moved acceptance of the Review of the Financial Secretary's report. Motion seconded and carried.

TREASURER'S REPORT.....MISSION GOAL.....MITES IN ACTION.....MISSION GRANTS

Marcia Reints Treasurer, stated that the Treasurer's Report is located on pages 33-34 of the Convention Manual. This report has been reviewed by LWML member Tamara McKay of the Davenport Zone and found to be in good order. Her statement can be found on page 32 of the Convention Manual. Reints moved acceptance of the Review of the Treasurer's report. Motion was seconded and carried. By direction of the Iowa East Board of Directors, Reints moved to adopt a Mission Goal for the 2016-2018 biennium of \$205,000, which includes \$95,735.00 for Mission Grants, \$33,394.50 for Outreach and \$75,870.50 for In-reach. Motion seconded and carried. The assembly stood and sang the "Doxology". To see our Mites in Action, Daniel Sanchez, Director of Camp Io-Dis-E-Ca, shared how the Mission Grant the camp received this biennium was used and provided an update on what is happening at the district camp. Cynthia Kofoot, Vice President of Gospel Outreach, presented the proposed Mission Grants (pages 36-40 of the Convention Manual) to be considered for the 2016-2018 Biennium. Darlene Read, VP of Human Care, offered a prayer before voting. Delegates were instructed to vote for five (5) mission grants. President Berquist gave the voting instructions. The tellers distributed and collected the ballots.

NOMINATING COMMITTEE REPORT....BALLOTING

Nominating Committee Chairman, Sandy Krause, presented the slate of candidates: Vice President of Organizational Resources: Grace Gotoski, Clinton Zone and Janell Wollschlager, Westgate Zone; Vice President of Communications: Betty Borchardt, St. Ansgar Zone and Cheryl Killham, Cedar Rapids Zone; Vice President of Human Care: Jill Fraser, Eldora Zone and Janice Johnston, Cedar Rapids Zone; Treasurer: Stephanie Behn, Eldora Zone and Gretchen Rasmussen, Mt. Pleasant Zone; Pastor Counselor: Pastor Michael Holmen, Westgate Zone and Pastor Randolph McHone, Waterloo Zone. President Berquist after asking for nominations from the floor of which there was none, declared the nominations closed. Kay Berry, Acting Davenport Zone President, led the prayer before balloting for the Election of Officers. Ballots were distributed; delegates were instructed to vote for one for each office. Barb Fremder led the assembly in singing.

LWML REPORT....ANNOUNCEMENTS

Cheryl Killham, Cedar Rapids Zone President, introduced the LWML Representative, Debbie Larson, Vice President of Organizational Resources. Larson brought greetings from President Patti Ross and the LWML Board of Directors. Julia Dlouhy and Melanie Maddick offered announcements. President Berquist shared additional announcements; then declared Session I of the 38th Biennial Convention of the LWML be closed. The Exhibit Hall was open from 4:30 pm – 6:15 pm.

FRIDAY EVENING

BANQUET.....KEYNOTE SPEAKER

The Banquet began at 6:30 pm with a welcome and prayer from Pastor David Rempfer, Senior Pastoral Counselor. Following dinner we were entertained with an LWML Trivia Game. Judy Westergren, Vice President of Organizational Resources, introduced the keynote speaker, Jan Wendorf, LWML President 2007-2011. The closing prayer was offered by Pastor David Lingard, Junior Pastoral Counselor. Exhibits were open from 9:00 pm – 10:00 pm

SESSION II – SATURDAY MORNING

OPENING DEVOTIONS....CREDENTIALS REPORT...SECOND OFFERING

The morning session began with group singing led by Barbara Fremder, song leader. President Joan Berquist welcomed the assembly to Session II of the 38th Biennial Convention of the Iowa East District..

Opening devotions were led by the Young Women Representatives introduced by Kathryn Schweer, Chairman of the Member Development Committee and assisted by committee member, Tamara McKay. Seated on stage was Marilyn Eglund, Parliamentarian; Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary; Judy Westergren, Vice President of Organizational Resources and Pastor David Lingard, Junior Pastoral Counselor. Crisis Management Team members were recognized. Offering #2, designated for the LWML IED Endowment Fund, was gathered, with the singing of "Lutheran Women, One and All". Diane Paulson, Recording Secretary, reported as of 8:00 am this morning there are 88 eligible delegates, nine District Officers, and 12 Zone Presidents for a total of 109 eligible to vote. Paulson moved the adoption of the official roll of the voting assembly. Motion seconded and carried. Berquist recognized LWML Iowa West District President, Ann Carrick and thanked her for coming to our convention. Alberta Martens, Clinton Zone President, led the assembly in reading the LWML Mission Statement.

BYLAWS...REBALLOT...MITES IN ACTION...BIBLE STUDY

Judy Westergren, Vice President of Organizational Resources, presented the Bylaw Proposed Amendments. The proposed bylaw amendments were approved by the LWML IED Board of Directors and the LWML Structure Committee. This past spring each society was provided a copy of the proposed amendments. By direction of the Board of Directors, Westergren moved that the bylaw amendments be approved as presented on pages 46-51 of the Convention Manual with the exception of Article 17, Section 8A on page 51 of the Convention Manual. Each article and section of the proposed bylaw amendments were read. Sharon Mulford-Hensen, Eldora Zone President led us in prayer before voting on the bylaw proposed amendments. Motion carried. By direction of the Board of Directors, Westergren moved that Article 17, Section 8A on page 51 of the Convention Manual be adopted. The article and section of the proposed bylaw amendment was read. There was a question from the floor on how the Endowment Fund was dispersing funds. President Berquist called Rad Finch, Ministry Advancement Officer, Lutheran Hour Ministries and former IED Gift Planning Counselor, who assisted in setting up the IED Endowment fund to explain the 5% annual disbursement of the Endowment fund. The question was answered and the chair called for the vote. Motion carried. The amended bylaws will be published and distributed to the Zone Presidents at the August 13, 2016 LWML IED Board of Directors meeting and/or they will be published on the LWML IED website. The Teller Chair of Elected Officers, Barb Jass informed the assembly that there was a tie for the Office of Vice President of Human Care. Delegates were instructed to vote for one candidate for VP of Human Care. Pastoral Counselor David Lingard led us in prayer before balloting. The tellers distributed and collected the ballots. During the 2014-16 Biennium, the LWML IED supported two Mission Grants through Mission Central. Gregg Happel, Mission Central representative, updated us on what is happening in the mission field. The Rev. David Lingard, Junior Pastoral Counselor led Bible study #1 based on Jeremiah 29:11. The ultimate GPS is found in Christ who died and rose for me.
