Four offerings will be received during Lutheran Women in Mission 41st Biennial Convention sessions. Offering recipients, chosen by the LWML Presidents Assembly are:

Convention Offering #1 LWML MISSION GOAL 2025–2027

The Standing Rules of the Lutheran Women's Missionary League state: The offering received at the convention Communion Service shall be designated as a contribution to the mission goal of LWML.

Convention Offering #2 CAMP LINN HAVEN/MOUNTAINSIDE LUTHERAN CHURCH NEWLAND, NC

Support Camp Linn Haven/Mountainside Lutheran Church and provide funds to help them with repairs to recover from the catastrophic damage inflicted by Hurricane Helene. Camp infrastructure damage estimated at over \$2 million.

Support Grace Point Institute for Relational Help to provide pastoral care and counseling for pastors and church workers.

Repairs for St. Paul's Lutheran School,

Cullman AL

St. Paul's Lutheran School in Cullman, Alabama, has been operating for 135 years, and the current school building is 60 years old and needs repair. An LWML Mission Grant of \$50,000 will help cover the cost of replacing windows, updating the heating and cooling technology to regulate temperatures in the classrooms, and replacing emergency doors that no longer lock properly, to keep the school safe.
