Here are a few interesting notes garnered from the reports found on lwml.org.

The **Bi-State Mission Walk**; the largest Mission Walk in Lutheran Women in Mission's history! More than 1,627 men, women, and children raised \$73,610.04 (preliminary amount) as they trekked across the beautiful Bob Kerry Pedestrian Bridge. That's a cumulative total of approximately 3,436,224 steps! (more steps than it takes to walk from St. Louis to Los Angeles. The bridge connects Nebraska and Iowa, making this a doubly historic mission walk that spans two states.
